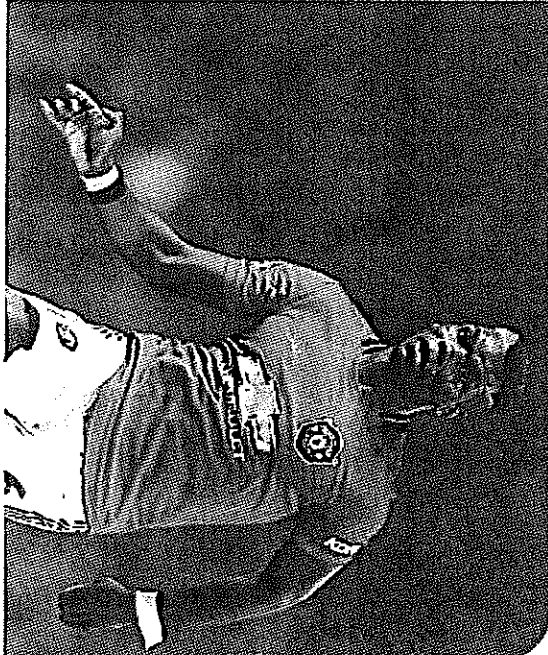

Inter Milan Is Also Interested in Pogba



El Inter se suma a la lista de equipos interesados en Paul Pogba. Antonino Camporese no le convence. Sensi y Barbera no son suficientes y, según La Gazzetta dello Sport, el técnico le habría pedido a su directora interior el fichaje del francés. La carrera del campeón del mundo explotó justo bajo las ordenes del italiano, durante su etapa en la Juventus, y ambos mantienen una gran relación.

Pogba, con su experiencia, su fuerza física y su poderío ofensivo, sería la incorporación perfecta para el club milanés. El consorte delegado Biaggio Marotta lo conoce muy bien (lo llevó a la Juve como agente libre en el 2012), pero debería convertirse a bajarse un estado que ahora ronda los 17 millones de euros netos, demasiado para la política del equipo. Eso sí, según el rotativo italiano, tres factores podrían favorecer a los nerazzurri: la fecha de caducidad del contrato del francés (2021), la muy favorable normativa fiscal italiana, y las ganas de crecer de Steven Zhang.

Al joven (y rico) presidente del Inter le molesta seguir a las espaldas de la Juventus y con los fichajes de Lukaku y Eriksen ya demostró sus ganas de convertirse al equipo en uno de los mejores de Europa. La entidad, además, podría financiar la operación con varios vances: Icardi (al menos 70 millones), Per-

sic, Vecchio y el posible adiós de Lautaro, que en Italia ya nadie excluye.

Inter Milan have joined the race to sign French international Paul Pogba with nerazzurri boss Antonio Conte unhappy with his current midfield. Eriksen has failed to convince the Italian, with Conte deeming that Sensi and Barbera not up to the task. La Gazzetta dello Sport report that the former Italian national team coach has requested the signing of Pogba with both men having worked together at Juventus and still retain a positive relationship. Pogba's salary may be a stumbling block for any potential move and club executive Biaggio Marotta has been enlisted with the task in convincing the player to take a drop in his current pay packet which works out at roughly 17 million euro per season. The Gazzetta adds that the player's current contract expiry date with Manchester United (30 June 2021) and Inter owner Steven Zhang's ambition for the club are factors in the Milan club's favour.

The Serie A side are expected to finance the deal with the sales of Sumner, with the likes of Icardi, Perisic, Vecchio and possibly Lautaro picking their bags.
